

INNA MOSHKOVICH

In her collection of acrylic paintings and more recent wool collages, Inna Moshkovich explores visual art's unparalleled communicative properties by constantly experimenting with new incarnations of form, texture, and color. From stormy grays and blues rendered in roughly textured yarn, to incandescent reds and yellows in glimmering paint, Moshkovich's works display an emotive sense of color. Her overall body of work, which spans from Impressionist style oils, to geometric abstraction and innovative collages of mixed mediums, is tied together by a persistent interest in creating layers of light and texture. Moving from the thick impasto brushstroke of paint to the rich tactile properties of wool collage, Moshkovich is driven by a strong desire to connect to the viewer through her bold aesthetic expression. By distorting natural subject matter into abstracted fields of intense texture and hue, Moshkovich creates an environmental canvas which not only delights and inspires the senses, but calls to the human spirit. The sublime atmospheric quality that characterizes much of Moshkovich's work not only reflects the artist's personal history growing up in the volatile climate of the Ukraine, but profoundly expresses the artist's internal emotions.

Born in Odessa, Ukraine, Inna Moshkovich now resides in Sydney, Australia. Moshkovich has exhibited her work in and around Sydney. Her new works were featured in the Florence Biennale 2007, Italy, and in February 2008 at Galleria Mentana, in the centre of Florence, Italy as part of a group exhibition titled *Individuals*.
