"Using colour came to me suddenly and felt more natural than using words in speech or writing. The shades of colour help to tell volumes of my soul's state. Unlike words, colour can't be misinterpreted. Each stroke is an opportunity for me to express my thoughts and feelings. I want to share my impressions of the surrounding world through experimenting with composition and colour. Using a palette knife in combination with brush strokes, I am trying to find my place in the rainbow of colour. "
